Re: 2019-2020 FLEF Scholarship Program

The Federal Law Enforcement Foundation is pleased to announce the continuation of our special Scholarship Program to benefit qualified children of qualified, full time employees of Federal Law Enforcement Agencies and supporting Law Enforcement Services. This includes state and local officers who are assigned to federal joint task forces based in New York, New Jersey, Connecticut and in certain other venues in which our Foundation is qualified. This scholarship is offered to children of Federal Law Enforcement Agents and State and local officers in the Greater Metropolitan area who were killed or disabled in the line of duty. Any law enforcement employee claiming disability has to be certified and approved by the appropriate agency head for eligibility.

Applications for the 2019-2020 Scholarship Program will be considered up to July 31, 2019. Scholarships are for the 2019-2020 academic year beginning in September, and the winners will be announced by October.

Here are the details of the Program:

- Scholarships will be awarded to children of full time active employees presently in the service of Federal Law Enforcement Agencies, including local officers and supporting Law Enforcement Services who are deputized and assigned to formal joint task forces, or children of agents killed in the line of duty. The Program will be open only to such qualified persons as described who are assigned in the greater Metropolitan area, inclusive of New York, New Jersey and Connecticut.
- Students must be fully matriculated to qualify for a scholarship, and must remain fully matriculated throughout the school year to receive the full scholarship award. Scholarships are not refundable in any part if a student discontinues attendance or fails to maintain full matriculation throughout the school year.
- Each scholarship will be a one-time cash grant paid directly to the institution selected by the applicant and their family for tuition, room & board or books. Tax consequences, if any, are the responsibility of the recipient. The applicant's parents or guardian must consent to the application and agree to accept any grant.

- To be eligible, completed applications must be received no later than July 31, 2019. (Application Attached)
- Selections for Scholarships will be based on many factors, including SAT Scores, academic achievement, (minimum eligibility of B or 3.0 average) above average community service, recommendations, and extracurricular activities.
- Only qualified individuals with the highest character, credentials and references will be considered. Each individual must maintain outstanding achievements during the college year in order to be considered for future grants.
- The Federal Law Enforcement Foundation has established a Scholarship Review Board to select students to receive scholarships. - No material changes will be permitted once the Scholarship Application has been received, such as changing schools or courses of study or full-time status, etc. If there are any changes, it is the obligation of the applicant to inform us **immediately**. If changes are made, the Foundation reserves the right to cancel the Scholarship. Any such changes must be approved by the Committee at the sole discretion of our Scholarship Review Board of the Federal Law Enforcement Foundation, Inc.

The Federal Law Enforcement Foundation was created in 1988 to assist and be an additional “safety net” for families of Federal Law Enforcement Agencies injured or killed in the line of duty, as well as those suffering from serious illness. In addition, over the years, the Foundation has helped subsidize special support for educational, informational and award programs assisting a wide variety of important organizations aimed primarily at helping the youth of America.

This program is open only to such qualified persons as described in the announcement letter of May 15, 2019 who are assigned in the Greater Metropolitan Area and other states where the Foundation is qualified. Any and all scholarship awards are subject solely to the discretion and approval of the Federal Law Enforcement Foundation, Inc.

Students must be fully matriculated to qualify for a scholarship. The scholarship award is submitted to the student's College/University and no portion of the scholarship is refundable if the student discontinues studies after the scholarship is awarded.
